Each share shall rank equally with an ordinary share for any sale, listing, or distribution on a winding up or other capital distribution which occurs before 22 May 2017 or to the extent of the proceeds up to a primary hurdle which occurs after 22 May 2017, as set out in the Articles of Association. The shares are not redeemable.

Shares are not entitled to vote. Shares are not entitled to receive a dividend other than in limited circumstances following an asset sale. Shares carry capital participation rights on sale, liquidation or listing, which occurs after 22 May 2017 subject to a primary hurdle as set out in the Articles of Association.
